### Triple Ring ADGA Sanctioned Senior Doe & Modified Jr Doe Show

WHERE: Southwest Washington Fairgrounds, Chehalis, WA. \*\*Cow Palace\*\*

**START TIME**: Youth Showmanship 8:00AM. If entry number warrant two showmanship classes will be held in ring #1 and one in ring #3: NIGERIAN DWARF SENIOR DOES 8:00 AM IN RING TWO. Standard breed Senior does will start in rings 1 & 3 --10 minutes after showmanship is completed.

DUE TO THE SCHEDULE IT IS EXTREMEMLY IMPORTANT FOR EXHIBITORS TO MONITOR THEIR MILKING DOES AS THEY ROTATE IN AND OUT OF THE RINGS FOR ALL THREE JUDGES. FOR THE HEALTH AND COMFORT OR YOUR DOES RELIEVE AS NEEDED!

Expect the Jr Doe show to start at about 6PM.

The Junior show will begin 20 minutes after the SENIOR Best In Show selections are made. This could be as early as 5:30PM. Exhibitors <u>only</u> entering in the JUNIOR SHOW should be on site and checked in by late afternoon. We will begin BEFORE 5:00 PM if the Senior show has finished, paperwork is done, and the judges are ready to go.

**ORDER OF SHOW:** We will be running three rings 'circus' style. Judges would judge <u>ALL</u> the breeds in their ring, before going to the next ring. The judge who begins in Ring 1 will move to Ring 2, then Ring 3- Judge in Ring 2 moves to Ring 3, then Ring 1- Judge in Ring 3 moves to Ring 1, then Ring 2. "The order of show **IS** subject to change."

It is EXTREMELY important for exhibitors to monitor their milking does to avoid over distended udders! Avoid possible harm to your animals and relieve them as necessary.

**ENTRY FEES PER RING**: \$7.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> 4 goats, \$5.00 for the 5<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> goats, and \$3.00 for the 10<sup>th</sup> goat and up if postmarked by May 11th -- \$9.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> 4 goats, \$7.00 for the 5<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> goats, and \$5.00 for the 10<sup>th</sup> goat and up if postmarked after May 11th – PENS ASSIGNED FOR PRE-ENTERED GOATS. If entering ON-LINE your time stamp will determine late fee.

NO ENTRY FEE FOR SHOWMANSHIP: Pre-entry appreciated—send name and age of participant.

SUBSTITUTIONS WITHIN THE BREED ONLY...Entries accepted up to 15 minutes prior to start of breed. NSF CHECKS WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL \$25.00 & EXHIBITION PRIVILEDGES SUSPENDED UNTIL ACCOUNT SETTLED.

#### NO PRE-SHOW MILKOUT

This is an ADGA sanctioned show, ADGA RULES SHALL GOVERN

#### Base date is date of show, May 19, 2018

The SWWDGA reserves the right to bar obviously ill or contagious animals. (animals refused must be kept in exhibitor's vehicle) Dogs must be leashed. Children must be under parental control at all times.

**SOUTHWEST WASHINGTON FAIRGROUNDS--** Exit #79 off I-5, turn east. Follow Fairgrounds signs...this will put you on a northbound one-way road. Turn left onto Exhibitors road. Then left onto southbound one-way and get over to right immediately so you can turn right between senior center and fairgrounds office. Enter grounds below blue Pavilion. The fairgrounds will be open for Friday night arrivals. Due to an event in the Blue Pavilion, all Dairy Goat vehicles should park by cattle wash area and north of Cow Palace. FIRE LANES must not be blocked!
